WHAT IS FORM FEST?

Form Fest is a **REQUIRED** event designed to get everyone on the same page for the school year from the very beginning. During this event, students will pay for required materials (shirts, shoes, gloves, flip folders, books, etc.). Incoming freshmen will obviously have more items to purchase to get started than upperclassmen will.

A complete list of fees can be find online at www.libertyhsband.com/registration; please take the time to study that information completely. There are some fees that are not required of everyone (FISD-owned instrument fees, for example) and options such as the Friday Nite Bites meal plan and extra materials.

Other required and necessary forms are also included online at www.libertyhsband.com/registration – please take the opportunity to fill out these forms now and then take super care to make sure the forms don't get lost so everything you need for registration will then be conveniently located in one place.

HOW DOES FORM FEST WORK?

As you enter the area (main auditorium doors), there will be "stations" set up along the way for you to stop and take care of some items (ie. Database confirmation, volunteer sign-up, permission forms, etc.). There will be plenty of band booster and BLT (Band Leadership Team) guidance to help you seamlessly through the process – we know your time is valuable and we want to make this process as quick and painless as possible, but also value making sure you are fully informed of the regular happenings of the band program, so be patient as we work together.

WHAT IF I NEED HELP GETTING FINANCIALLY STARTED WITH BAND FOR THIS YEAR?

A limited amount of funds from the Redhawk Band Boosters Association, Inc. is available to help families that qualify with some* of the fees associated with band. If you need this help, please speak with Mr. Weaver on the day of registration. In addition, booster representatives will be here to help in any way they can. While all our fees are available for payment online, options are also available for paying by check or for setting up a payment plan. We are here to help!

HOW THE REGISTRATION PROCESS WORKS

When you arrive for registration (see the schedule of events for your time), you will go through "stations" to complete the process. More detail about each station can be found at www.libertyhsband.com/registration.

- **STATION 1** *CHECK-IN and INSPECTION* Drum Majors will inspect to make sure you have all your necessary items (see inspection list to know what to bring)
- **STATION 2** *CUTTIME DATABASE UPDATE* we need you to enter and verify **ALL** contact information, grade information, etc.
- STATION 3 MEDICAL RELEASE & UIL PHYSICAL FORMS turn in your printed, completed, and signed forms here.
- STATION 4 UIL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT turn in your printed, completed, and signed form here.
- **STATION 5** *VOLUNTEERS* members of the Redhawk Band Boosters will be here to answer questions about Volunteering.
- **STATION 6** *MEAL PLAN* members of the Redhawk Band Boosters will be here to answer questions about the Meal Plan and guide you through the online form.
- **STATION 7** *SPIRIT WEAR* stop here to buy/order your Liberty HS SWAG for the year.
- **STATION 8** *UNIFORMS* head to the band hall to meet with the uniform team.
- **STATION 9** *FINANCE* our treasurer and finance team will be here to take your fees and checklist at this time. (Checks, if necessary, are payable to *Redhawk Band Boosters Association, Inc.*)

When you have completed **ALL** the stations, turned in all your forms, and paid all your fees - you are free to go home. We will see you again on Monday, May 13th from 4:50-7:30 PM for Music Camp (www.libertyhsband.com/calendar).
