



# HOW TO ... UIL SOLO AND ENSEMBLE CONTEST

## CONTEST DAY INSTRUCTIONS

### TRANSPORTATION

Students will be responsible for making their own transportation arrangements to and from the Solo and Ensemble site. Parents are more than welcome to stay and listen to their child's performance(s). There is no cost for spectators.

Students should arrive no later than 45 minutes prior to their schedule performance time allowing themselves time to locate their room, warm-up, etc.

Students are free to leave immediately following their performance.

### WHAT YOU NEED

Instrument – please do NOT leave your instrument at school on Friday night as no one will be available to let you in to retrieve it.

ORIGINAL music to be given to your judge.

COPY of your music from which to perform.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO LOOK LIKE

Please dress “business professional” for this event. Yes, gentlemen should wear a tie. Please do NOT wear white athletic socks – especially if you are wearing black pants.

### PROCEDURE

Before you perform, please introduce yourself, your accompanist, and the piece you are about to perform.

When you are finished, be sure to thank your judge for listening to you, thank your accompanist for playing for you.

Contest workers will retrieve your judge's form and return it to the contest office. You may (if you wish) retrieve your original music or just wait and we will return your music with your judge's form.

Results will be posted online throughout the day by UIL. Judge's sheets and medals will be distributed in class on the following Monday.
