

Liberty High School Redhawk Band Booster Association Scholarship Standing Rules

- A. The Frisco Education Foundation (FEF) is responsible for selecting and managing the scholarship award. The FEF will receive applications, determine eligibility, advertise the availability and distribute funds. The Liberty High School Redhawk Band Booster Association (RBBA) submits criteria but does NOT select scholarship recipients.
- B. The award is a one-time lump sum of \$500.
- C. The following criteria are used to determine eligibility:
 - a. The student is a graduating senior and a member of the Liberty HS Redhawk Band.
 - b. The student has a minimum GPA of 3.0.
 - c. The student's family must be a current member of the Redhawk Band Booster Association.
 - i. RBBA membership will be required for all 4 years.
 - ii. Note: For student who joins the Liberty HS Redhawk Band later in the program, RBBA membership is waived for the year(s) the student is not a member of the band.
 - d. The student must have volunteered for a minimum of 10 hours from January of junior year to December of senior year (example: for Class of 2024, from January to December of 2023). 5 hours must be with Liberty HS Fine Arts programs (Band, Orchestra, and related activities). The student needs to keep track of their service hours in Xello which is available through Liberty HS website. Only hours that have been verified in Xello will be counted. Once the student submits their volunteer hours for verification, it takes about 2 weeks for the school to update the student's record. Hours for required band / guard events will not count toward the minimum hours.
 - e. Financial need is not a requirement.
 - f. The funds may be used for any furthering accredited education programs; such as 4 year university, junior college, trade or technical school, etc.
 - g. The student must be in good financial standing with no outstanding fees due to the band.
